

- ▶ Only use Trico Original Equipment Manufacturer ("OEM") replacement parts.
- Never operate without grease or if the bearing or threads are damaged and rotation is impeded.
- Never exceed the maximum working load of the Spinner.



New Equipment Specifications

▶ Maximum Working Load: 25 short tons (50,000 lbs).

Before Each Use

- Ensure the stem freely rotates in both directions, and is tightly secured to the body.
- ▶ Ensure the bearing is lubricated for every 8 hours of operation using a NLGI certified grease meeting GC-LB standards.
- Check the condition of the bearing. *High rotational speeds and heavy operating loads reduce bearing life.*
- Replace the bearing if it is damaged or rotation is impeded.
- Check the threads for damage.
